- The Summer school in communication of scientific research (CSR) is addressed to young scientists drawn from different countries and disciplinary fields: PhD students and post-doctoral fellows in the natural, social and human sciences;
- the CSR Summer school is dedicated to the theory and practice of communication of scientific research, by providing the basic instructions on the construction of written and oral text, with analysis in class of written and oral contributions by the participants;
- an intensive experience of study and sharing, far from working daily life, for deepening this topic and apply it as a class.

Summer CSR school 2021 at the glance

- **Location:** Viterbo, Nazareth Residence;
- **term:** August 3-5, 2021 (daily from 9.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.);
- **programme:** theoretical and practical lectures, group work on written and oral communication, analysis in class of contributions made by the participants, meetings with guests drawn from different disciplinary fields and professional contexts, study and dialogue;
- **participants:** young researchers (PhD students and post-doctoral fellows) in the natural, social and human sciences. The CSR school **is particularly addressed to non-Italian young researchers;**
- **language:** English;
- **registration fee:** € 500 which does not include accommodation and meals;
- **accommodation:** Nazareth Residence (B&B hospitality);
- **meals:** participants will dine together in the surroundings of the Residence and the city center;
